## The Tri-Safe Project are proud to announce – THE EVENT

The **EVENT** is the culmination of the Tri-Safe Project. This project has required a lot of hard work by a lot of people and our thanks go out to all of them.

The Tri-Safe project comprises of three individual projects:

**10.30am – 3.30 pm**

- Razed Roof – an Inclusive drama group based at the Playhouse Theatre in Harlow. Razed Roof have been running drama workshops, with a range of schools (including a Primary, a Special and Secondary) plus Harlow Youth Council, to raise awareness of the difficulties people with a learning disability face on a daily basis. The students are being asked to go back to cascade the information within their school; they will then develop their ideas to portray what they have learnt from their workshop: this may take the form a piece of drama, a poem, a piece of prose, or the creation of a piece of art work. These works will be performed and displayed at the Playhouse on the 10<sup>th</sup> November.
- Basildon Hate Crime workshops – these workshops highlight what hate crime is and what to do should you experience or witness it. Issues highlighted within their workshops are being fed into Razed Roof's sessions for them to talk about within their workshops.
- Everyday Lives – a photographic project which consists of photographs taken by people with and without a learning disability. It is expected that there will be no difference, illustrating just how able people with a learning disability are. The materials created within this project will also be on display at the Playhouse Theatre for a week starting on 9<sup>th</sup> November, and can be enjoyed as part of The Event.

For The Event, performances by the school children will take place from 10.30am and will fill the morning session. During the afternoon Razed Roof members will demonstrate some of their work and there may be some repeat performances by the schools.
